CCYC TERMS & CONDITIONS OF BERTHING & STORAGE

1. Applications will not be considered from a Member if their subscriptions or other dues are in arrears. In the event of subscriptions or other monies due falling in arrears, existing berth holders will forfeit their entitlement to site facilities.
2. Fees for site facilities are due and payable on demand against invoice and should be paid promptly. In respect of annual fees due, any invoices outstanding after 31st January will result in the relevant facility being offered to another member on the Waiting List.
3. The member shall be liable for and shall indemnify the Club in respect of any claim against the Club for loss, damage, salvage and third party claims made against the Club as a result of the actions of the member or users of the vessel, trailers or cradles subject to this agreement.
4. In respect of berthing and storage facilities, and without prejudice to the member's obligation to indemnify the Club under Term 3, appropriate marine third party insurance cover must be taken out and held, with a minimum cover of £2,000,000. Insurance cover should also include lifting by crane or winch where applicable. Additionally outboards stored on site must be covered.
5. Vessels must be maintained in a seaworthy condition. Cradles and trailers must also be properly maintained to a reasonable and safe standard.
6. Members who have taken out the Marina Package, Dry Sailing Package or Mud Berth must use their vessels a minimum of five times a year. In the event that they do not, they will be requested to move the vessel from site to enable members on the Waiting List to take up the space.
7. Vessels must be cleared from the crane area as soon as possible and particularly from the pontoon area beneath the crane. Vessels may not be left in the crane slings for more than one hour.
8. In no circumstances should vessels (afloat or ashore), trailers or cradles be positioned in a way that prevents or impedes access to or movement of other berth holders' vessels, trailers or cradles.
9. Members must seek the approval of the Hon. Bosun for the lift, storage and re-launch of their vessels as appropriate. Only personnel authorised by the Hon. Bosun may operate machinery and supervise site movement and blocking off. Non-members may NOT use the crane or winch.
10. Vessels must be positioned as directed by the Hon. Bosun.
11. Any damage to Club Property or to any member's vessels or equipment must be reported to the Hon. Bosun.
12. The Club reserves the right to move any vessel and/or gear at its discretion.
13. All fuel must be stored in approved containers.
14. All cautionary notices must be adhered to.
15. Club members are responsible for the security of their lockers. No flammable items or liquids may be kept in lockers. No smoking is allowed in the locker area.

NOTE

The use of club assets or available facilities not specified overleaf, or variations to those specified (e.g. Marina Package with storage for a period off site) will be subject to charges at the discretion of the Hon. Bosun and Secretary.
