Dredging

The Medina Estuary is silting up due to changes in tidal flow, resulting in loss of depth and shallow spots in our marina and others nearby. Every few years we have to have the marina and basin dredged, a very expensive and laborious activity. Dredging had been planned to take place this spring before the sailing season started, but unfortunately the issue of necessary licences was delayed making it impossible to complete in time.

The dredging programme has therefore been postponed, probably until autumn 2024 - watch for more details.
