NOTICE OF RACE (REV 3, *changes in italics*)

Saturday 10 September 2022

In case of inclement weather, may be postponed to the following day

1. Organising Authority

1.1 The Race is organised by Cowes Corinthian Yacht Club.

2. Rules

2.1 The Race will be governed by the rules as defined in World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020.

2.3 Classes racing as one design must conform to their class rules.

2.4 All entries will be allocated a handicap using the CCYC rating system from the information provided.

2.5 If there is conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions the Sailing Instructions shall take precedence. This changes RRS 63.7.

3. Eligibility and Entry

3.1 The race is open to all sailing keelboats up to 12m l.o.a. Including any fixed bowsprit of any class.

3.2 Entries shall be made on the attached form and returned to Cowes Corinthian Yacht Club at the address below by 17:00 on 7 September 2022. Boats already entered and paid-up in CCYC 2022 Weekend Series are free of charge. Entries may be submitted by e-mail provided that any fee is paid to the CCYC office by closing date.

4. Fees

4.1 The Entry Fee is £20 per boat, no VAT, to be paid to the Club Office not later than Wed 7th Sept 2022

6. Class Flags

6.1 A banner will be issued to each paid-up entrant which must be displayed from a backstay or spreader

7. Sailing instructions

7.1 The Sailing instructions will be available on the Club website on or after 03 September 2022.

8. The Courses

8.1 The racing area will be the Solent starting from the Cowes Corinthian Startline at buoy #34.

8.2 The course will be described in the Sailing Instructions. Competitors are strongly advised to take careful note of the SIs and to study them in good time having account of forecast conditions.

9. Radio Communications

9.1 All boats shall carry a VHF transceiver capable of operation on VHF channel 77.

9.2 Postponement or abandonment will be notified by VHF. No flags will be used. This changes RRS 26.

9.3 All signals will be made by broadcast on VHF. No flag signals will be used. This changes RRS 26.

10. Scoring / Results

10.1 The results will be calculated based on handicaps allocated according to NoR 2.3 above.

11. Prizes

11.1 The Cowes Corinthian Challenge Trophy (perpetual) will be awarded to the first boat overall on corrected time.

11.2 Keeper prizes will be awarded for the first three boats overall on corrected time.

12. Risk Statement

12.1 Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- (a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- (b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- (c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- (d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- (e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats, and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- (f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance as is available in Cowes, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.
- (g) It is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held for the event.
- (h) By entering or taking part in this event they agree to comply with all guidance issued by HM Government and the RYA in respect of Covid-19

13. Insurance

13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000 Sterling per incident or the equivalent.
